POLICY:

The following Laboratory tests will be performed as STAT (Medical Emergency) upon order of the attending physician. STAT must be indicated as the priority on the requisition.

All STAT specimens will be tested in order of receipt.

Inpatient results will be electronically broadcasted to the nursing unit ordering the STAT test.

Outpatient STAT results will be telephoned to the physicians ordering the STAT test.

A test should only be ordered as STAT if the results are needed in less than one (1) hour.

STATs should not be left in the Laboratory without notifying the Laboratory staff.

Tests marked with ** have a TAT of 2 HR due to the nature of the methodology.
