<b>ABO/Rh</b>	Banded specimen.  ABO/Rh type performed.  Additional testing can be added– antibody screen or Rhogam work up.	Blood- Order type and cross and nursing transfuse order.  FFP or Platelets– Order type and screen, order for FFP or Platelets and nursing transfuse order.	Blood– with negative anti-body screen– 50 min.  FFP-35-40 min.  Platelets– 5-10 min.
<b>Type and screen</b>	Banded specimen.  ABO/Rh and antibody screen performed.  *Additional testing can be added– crossmatch or antibody ID.	Blood– Order crossmatch additional units and nursing transfuse order.  FFP or Platelets– Order for FFP or Platelets and nursing transfuse order.	Blood– with negative anti-body screen– 5-10 min.  FFP– 35-40 min.  Platelets– 5–10 min.
<b>Type and Cross</b>	Banded specimen.  *ABO/Rh, antibody screen, and RBC packed cells crossmatched performed and ready for transfusion.	Blood– Order crossmatch additional units and nursing transfuse order.  FFP or Platelets– Order for FFP or Platelets and nursing transfuse order.	Blood– with negative anti-body screen– 5-10 min.  FFP– 35-40 min.  Platelets– 5–10 min.

\*Positive antibody screen will be called to unit and availability of blood will be determined case by case.
