In addition to conventional or classical chromosome studies, we also offer molecular cytogenetic diagnostic studies by fluorescence in situ hybridization (FISH) methodologies for both cancer and congenital applications and microarray studies. The Molecular Pathology Laboratory is an expanding service offering a variety of high complexity testing. The laboratory concentrates on both constitutional genetic disorders and oncologic mutational analysis using the most up to date techniques and methodologies including next generation sequencing. The Division of Cytopathology offers a full range of services including ThinPrep Pap Test, Non-Gyn (urine, body fluids, brushings, washing and Fine Needle Aspiration using state of the art technology). Our dedicated cytopathologists offer ultrasound-guided FNA procurement of palpable lesions at the FNA Clinic with cytotechnologists providing on-site FNA adequacy assessment.
